



# Scotch Hall

Rial Corporation, the parent company of Scotch Hall Preserve, has ordered the directive upon us to close all customer related operations beginning on Monday, March 30, 2020, until further notice and at which time a date can be determined that we are able to return to our normally scheduled operations. This measure is being done to help protect our employees, our property owners, our members, and our guests from the future spread of COVID-19. As of this notification posting, we cannot predict when Scotch Hall Preserve will return to our normally scheduled operations, but we are anticipating that all customer related operations at Scotch Hall Preserve will remain closed through the entirety of the month of April 2020.

Player's Pass Members we have altered the annual pass membership deadline dates for anyone who has not renewed their membership as well as extended the current March 31 expiration date to allow those to still receive the discounted Player's Pass once we do open for normal operations. Player's Pass Members that have already renewed their membership will have their 2020-2021 Player's Pass extended to include a 12-month period as to when we do reopen.

At this time, we have decided to also move up the aerification schedule to coincide with the beginning of the customer related operations closures to prevent any further delay in standard operations once we do reopen for normal business procedures. A decision to allow Members and Player's Pass Members the opportunity to walk the golf course during the closure is being discussed and a later announcement will be made regarding that decision.
